Spring



Golden Alexander Zizia aurea It is a host plant for Black Swallowtails, Ozark Swallowtails, Rigid Sunflower Borers, and supports Mining Bees. Height: 3 ft



Foxglove Beard Tongue Penstemon digitalis It supports pollinators like Bumble Bees, Small Carpenter Bees, Syrphid Flies, and is a host plant for Mason Bees. Height: 5 ft



Virginia Bluebells Mertensia virginica It supports pollinators in the early spring when many nectar sources aren't yet available. Heiaht: 2 ft



Ohio Spiderwort Tradescantia ohiensis It supports pollinators like Small Sweat Bees, Small Carpenter Bees, Mason Bees, Eastern Tiger Swallowtail, and Bee Flies. Height: 3 ft

Summer



Partridge Pea Chamaecrista fasciculata It supports pollinators like Long-Horned bees, Bumble Bees, and Silver Spotted Skippers.

Height: 2 ft



Butterfly Milkweed Asclepias tuberosa It supports pollinators like Leafcutter Bees, and is a host plant for the Monarch Butterfly, and Queen Butterfly. Height: 2 ft



Wild White Indigo Baptisia alba It supports pollinators like Small Sweat Bees, Bumble Bees and is a host plant for Clouded Sulphers, and Genista Broom Moth. Height: 4 ft



Purple Prairie Clover Dalea purpurea It supports pollinators like Green Sweat Bees and Bumble Bees and is a host plant for Southern Dogface and many bees species. Height: 2 ft

Fall



New England Aster Symphyotrichum novae-angliae It supports over 50 bee species and is a host plant for Pearl Crescents, and Canadian Sonia Moths. Height: 5 ft



Stiff Goldenrod Solidago rigida It supports pollinators like Long-Horned Bees, Bumble Bees, and is a host plant for Dart Moths and over 57 pollen specialist bees. Height: 4 ft



Meadow Blazing Star Liatris ligulistylis It supports pollinators like Monarchs, Painted Ladies, Bee Flies, Leafcutter Bees, and is a host plant for a few bee species. Height: 5 ft



Bee Balm Monarda fistulosa It supports pollinators like Monarchs, Mason Wasps, Bumble Bees, and is a host plant for Hermit Sphinx Moths and Snout Moths. Height: 4 ft
